### 911 RESPONSES

Emergency Medical response is the basic and most fundamental service the volunteer member provides. Each year, our volunteers provide an average of 26000 hours. SEMS responds to over 6500 calls a year. Our diverse call volume is an excellent learning opportunity for those seeking to enhance their EMS skills and/or gain valuable experience in EMS. Our staff is friendly, professional and compassionate.

### PROGRESSIVE EMS SYSTEM

### SPECIAL OPERATIONS DIVISION

Our Special Operations Division (SOD) respond to unplanned major incidents, planned special events, structure fires to provide medical rehab and any other time a request for SOD is made.
