What is provided to the student:

Basic provider equipment, including:

- Stethoscope
- Blood pressure cuff
- Penlight
- Shears
- Uniform Shirt
- Online Text Book

What does the student need (not provided):

- Uniform pants, navy blue (Dickies, EMS pants)
- Black rubber sole boots & black belt

Students are expected to be in uniform and to bring their books and other required materials to in-person class/practicals.
