Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) Course State of Connecticut Office of EMS Approved

This 165-hour Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course is designed to prepare learners for eligibility to test for National Registry of Emergency Medical Technicians (NREMT) and Connecticut EMT certification. The curriculum provides comprehensive instruction in cognitive, psychomotor, and affective domains, including patient assessment, airway and ventilation management, CPR, medical and traumatic emergencies, cardiac and respiratory care, hemorrhage control, shock management, immobilization, obstetrics, pediatrics, ambulance operations, and EMS safety. Instruction emphasizes evidence-based practice, critical thinking, effective communication, and professional behavior consistent with NREMT standards. The course includes a supervised ambulance internship, during which learners ride on ambulances and participate in patient care activities under the direct supervision of credentialed EMS providers. This clinical experience brings together classroom knowledge and real-world prehospital environments which prepares learners to be competent work-force ready providers upon successful completion.
